

## **NAUI Rescue Dive Course**

**Tuition:** \$259

**Course Dates:** Feb 24th, 25th, 27th, 28th

**Location:** Seattle Lighthouse

This course trains divers in the knowledge and skills needed to manage risks and effectively handle limited in-water problems and diving emergencies. Included are: assists, transports, surface rescues and rescues from depth involving both boat and shore based skin and scuba divers.

### **Course Prerequisites**

**Age:** Minimum is 15 years.

**Certification:** Training and experience equivalent to NAUI Scuba Diver.

**CPR & First Aid Certification:** current certification in both is required for certification.

### **Other Prerequisites:**

- Swim 220 yards nonstop, any stroke, in ten minutes or less.
  - Survival swim for 10 minutes.
  - Recover 16 pounds from 8 to 12 feet of water.
  - Recover simulated unconscious skin diver from 8 to 12 feet of water.
  - Perform fin push on a conscious scuba diver on surface.
  - Transport another diver of equal size 20 yards in the do-se-do position.
  - Transport another diver of equal size out of open water.

## **NAUI First Aid / CPR/ Oxygen Administration**

**Tuition:** \$149 (Materials included)

**Course Dates:** Feb 22nd and 23rd

**Location:** Seattle Lighthouse

NAUI First Aid can be conducted as a comprehensive course including all the segments (First Aid, CPR, AED, Blood-borne Pathogens and Emergency Oxygen Administration) in a single schedule or each of the segments may be delivered separately to meet specific needs of the students who may only need training in one discipline or another. Certification and recognition materials are delivered in a package with the textbook and are designed to be flexible so that you may name some or all of the qualifications earned. In any case the certification is valid for a two year period after which the student must complete refresher training, and a practical and theoretical exam.
